Because of the pandemic, the Cookie Walk was cancelled this past December. However, we still have students in need of scholarships.



Saint Mary Faith Formation ...

March 21 Confirmation Retreat from 10 AM to 5 PM at St. Joseph

John 12:20–33 In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus faces religious leaders who are plotting against him. Many Jews and Greeks in Jerusalem were coming to him, and this angered Jesus' opponents. Jesus explains his fate by using the parable of a grain of wheat falling to the ground. Unless it dies, it remains a single grain. If the seed dies, it will produce a rich harvest.

Catholic Relief Services (CRS) Timor-Leste is a small Asian country, slightly larger than the state of Connecticut. It's on the other side of the world near Australia, and it's one of the world's newest countries—only 18 years old. In comparison, the United States will be 245 years old this year!

Many families in Timor-Leste live in rural areas and work as farmers. But challenges like changing weather patterns make it difficult to grow enough food. They depend on rice as a main part of their meals, and



hunger and malnutrition are big problems. More than one-third of people in Timor-Leste don't have reliable access to enough nutritious food. This especially affects children and their ability to develop to their full potential.

- 1 large onion, diced
- 5 cloves garlic, minced
- 3 tbsp fair trade olive oil
- 3 cups water
- 1 butternut squash, cut into small pieces
- 110-oz. bag frozen corn
- 115-oz. can red kidney beans, drained
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 cups cooked rice

Sauté onion and garlic in olive oil over medium

heat until tender. Add water and squash, and increase heat until water is simmering. Add corn and kidney beans, reduce to medium heat, and cook stirring occasionally for 15 to 20 minutes until squash is tender. Add salt and pepper to taste. Serve with rice.


