 Our Holy Week liturgies were beautiful! Thanks to all the planning and organizing done by Lisa Meyers at St. Mary and Laura Kisting at St. Joseph. I also thank those who got "livestreamed Mass" going and have



been making upgrades as we go—Laura Kisting at St. Joseph and Vicki Kersten at St. Mary. It's been over a year, and it has been much appreciated! I am grateful to Fr. Ray Dischler, my friend from Madison, for celebrating Mass at 10:00 a.m. on Easter Sunday at St. Mary.

- The Diocese has now permitted us to visit parish members who are under age 65 in their homes (a few weeks ago we had permission to visit those over 65). We will still practice mask wearing, distancing, and other appropriate measures.
- At St. Joseph, I am hearing confessions after every Saturday Mass and after the first two Sunday Masses of each month. Some guidelines for confessions: the red light above the door indicates that I am in the booth; there are two side rooms next to the booth (one has a kneeler, one has a chair), and I ask that only one side room be occupied at a time; as soon as one person leaves, I ask that the next person enter (I will leave when there is a 5-minute span without penitents). Please let me know of any questions.


St. Mary Mass Intention Policies

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for a deceased loved one is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition. In our parish, there are many requests for scheduling such Mass intentions. As a way to allow as many parishioners and friends as possible to schedule Mass intentions, the following policies are put forth to help make the process easy and fair to all.

- 1. The date that the books open for scheduling Mass intentions will be published in the bulletin. Mass intentions will be scheduled on a first come, first served basis
- 2. Beginning **immediately**, we will schedule no more than 10 intentions per household; only two of the ten may be for Sunday (Saturday evening) Masses. If a household's limit has been reached, new requests may only be made for newly deceased loved ones.
- 3. A \$10 stipend, as determined by Diocesan policy, is to accompany each Mass intention request.
- 4. Mass intentions will NOT be scheduled for Christmas, Holy Week or Easter Sunday Masses. The intention for these Masses will be for the deceased members of the parish or the specific intentions of the priest.
- 5. Church law requires only one intention per Mass. However, we will permit: one intention with up to 3 first names with the same last name (i.e. John, Paul and Mary Smith) or one intention with two last names only (i.e. the Jones and Smith Families).
- 6. Mass intentions can be scheduled with Lisa Meyers in the Parish office Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, from 9:00 a.m. to Noon If you are unable to schedule in person, you can call or email Lisa 608-868-3335; <u>lisa.meyers.sm@gmail.com</u>. She will return your communication in a timely manner with Mass times as close to your chosen date as possible.
