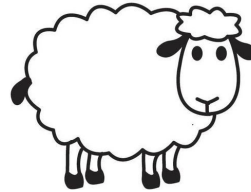
Stewardship: A Way of Life

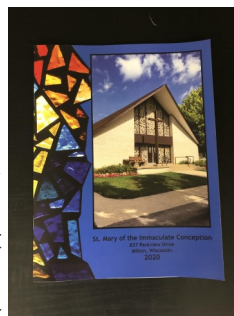

VENITE ADOREMUS

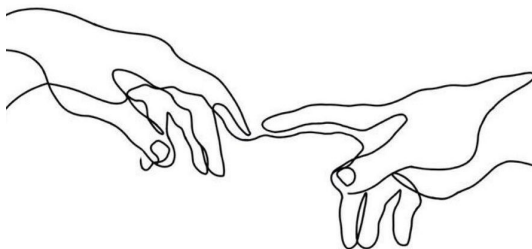
