## *A Note from Our Pastor ...*



- ✚ Please come to the Memorial Day Mass on Monday, May 31 at 8:30 a.m. at St. Mary Cemetery. Bring your lawn chairs. If weather is bad, we will meet in St. Mary Church.
- ✚ The Madison Diocese is gradually moving back to normal in the sense of removing covid restrictions. Here are the changes and their dates: May 22--holy water fonts are back in use; May 29—the Sign of Peace is included in Mass (no one is pressured, remember that you can nod or wave); June 5—those who distribute Communion don't need to wear masks; June 11—we may start congregational singing; June 12 and 13--Masses will end with a hymn to Mary in gratitude for her intercession for the Church during the pandemic. For the next few weeks we will keep the “distancing” section in our churches (sections adjacent to the center aisle at St. Joseph, and east half of church at St. Mary).
- ✚ Planning for the building project at St. Mary's is making progress. Our building committee has started making plans and estimates with an architect while our finance people have been interviewing fundraising companies. In a few weeks we will begin a feasibility study to see how much in funds we might reasonably raise. This cycles back to our design/plan: we can only design what we can afford. The church is in good shape, but the “parish center” (south of church) and the old rectory (north of church) are in bad shape. The main driver in all of this is the structural state of the parish center: water leaks through the ceiling, which we are trying to keep away from our office computers, and we have steadily failing heating and air conditioning systems. Other factors are the difficulty of conducting faith formation classes in the center and the unusable status of the old rectory due to mold coming from the basement, and there are other factors. We are hoping we can make it through this summer and next winter and begin construction next spring. This will be a major effort, with a likely cost of \$2-4 million (it is still being figured). I want to raise our awareness of this need by conducting short tours of the parish center and old rectory after Masses starting next weekend. I hope you can join me.

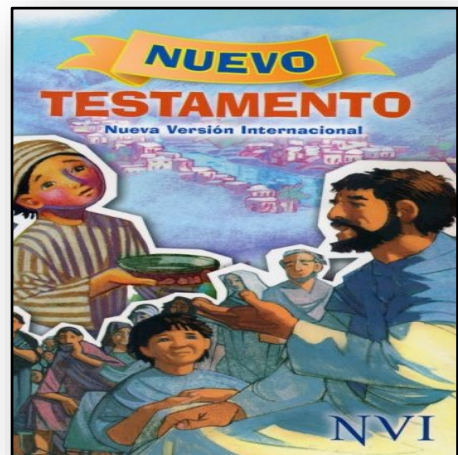
A few weeks ago, a parishioner called to ask what we can do for the migrant children. I contacted Fr. Franciscus at St. Joseph Church in Donna, Texas, at which my in-laws attended as snowbirds. Did you know that 75% of the children are Catholic? Here are three correspondences:

*"Thank you so much for your concern. Yes, in my area in Donna Texas, we have a large number of Children from South America and Central America. They are need to our special spiritual support, because the government of USA take care of them, but they are need spiritual support and prayer for right now. Some of them have a Covid-19 and they were suffering with this virus and some of them were struggling to get here and long process, some of them have a traumatic problem. I will visit them this Sunday and celebrate mass with them. Hopefully I can get information more clearly about what are they need, and I will inform you."*

*"Thank you so much for your concerned to the children and the families who are the refugees. Some of them are already taking up from the camp, but some of them are still there. We are a local church in here try to support them in prayer and education included with religious education. We give them bible and classes for faith formation program and we are happy to be with them. Our bishop Daniel E Flores supports this program and we do have respite center for the children who are already traveling in USA and we accommodate the shelter that they can stay before they are traveling."*

*"I would like inform you that yesterday I went to the camp to celebrate mass with the children. They allowed me to have had mass in the camp with the Children. Thanks be to God because it is not easy for us to go there. I have two group of the Children who was attending mass, because of the capacity. It was nice and momentum with them. They want to have prayer book and rosary to pray."*

If you would like to help the children continue their Catholic Christian faith formation, we are collecting donations for children's Bibles, \$1.59 each or \$63.60 for a case of 40 that can be shipped directly to St. Joseph in Texas for free. ## PASTORAL COUNCIL AND TRUSTEE ELECTIONS - St. Mary, Milton:

Each year the congregation is invited to nominate parishioners for the three soon-to-be vacant positions on our Pastoral Council and one soon-to-be-vacant position of Parish Trustee. Pastoral Council members are elected for a term of 3 years and Trustees are elected for a term of 2 years.

Because of the pandemic last year, it was determined not to hold an election. The Council and Trustee members whose terms were expiring, agreed to serve for an extra year. Because of this, our election will look a little different this year.

Our ballot will include replacing three members whose term will end in **two years** instead of three, and three additional members whose term will end in **three years**. The Trustee ballot will include electing one member for a **one year term**, and electing another member for **two years**.

The nomination process began last weekend. Paper forms are available in the Gathering Space at church. The deadline for submitting nominations is Sunday, May 30.



Next each nominee will be invited to attend a special prayer service in church to obtain additional information and discern if having their name on the ballot is their calling at this time.

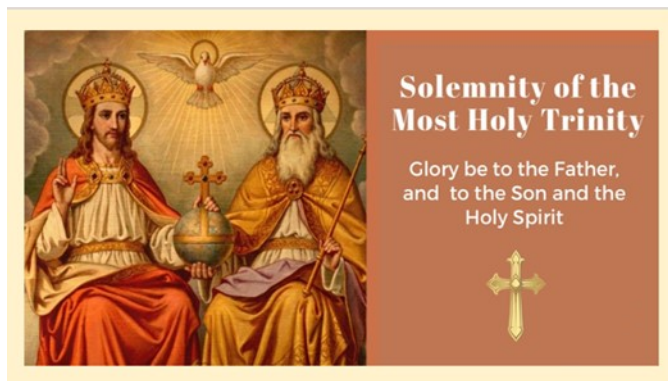
