A Note from Our Pastor ...



- ✝ After a long pause during the pandemic, St. Mary is once again returning to its building project. We are grateful that the church is in good shape, and we plan to keep it as is. However, the old rectory (south wing) has roof problems (sagging, insulation and ventilation problems), inefficient windows, mold has seeped into the old concrete, and it is not suited for parish activities. The parish center (north wing) has troubles with heating and air conditioning and a leaky roof that causes distress when snow melts in spring and when it rains. There are also serious challenges with conducting our faith formation classes in the center. The staff, Finance Council, Buildings and Grounds Committee, and Capital Improvement Committee think it may be best to raze those parts of the building and build new offices and parish center/faith formation classroom space. The issues are urgent enough to make us want to begin building in spring 2022. We have resumed our meetings with an architect and are developing design options. If we are to go forward, we will require support from parish members in the form of fundraising. For comparison, our most recent fundraising effort was in 2015, when we raised \$407,000 for Priests for Our Future, and this new project would require several times, perhaps even ten times, that amount. This will be a major effort, and the leaders of our parish are trying to consider all options and what is best and what is possible for our parish. I will try to keep you all informed as we go, and I will also be seeking your input as we hope to begin a feasibility study soon.
- ✝ In this Easter season we looked at the amazing events of Acts chapters 3 and 4, where God healed a man crippled from birth, and it led to multiple opportunities for the apostles to proclaim Jesus—his death and resurrection. The high point was at the end, when the whole church of Jerusalem gathered and lifted their voices to God and prayed: “Enable your servants to speak your word with all boldness.” The Catholic Church uses this event as a basis for its mission to proclaim Jesus (*Catechism* #425).

✝ I hope that many of us have been vaccinated against the corona virus. Please take the time to send a letter to the company that made your vaccination (Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J). We thank them for their vaccines, yet we also ask that in the future they develop vaccines without using cell lines from aborted babies. Some very good letters are found at usccb.org/resources/letters-pharmaceutical-companies. The address for each company is given, and all you need to do is sign it.

Bishop Donald Hying would like to honor couples celebrating 50 years of marriage in 2021 in one or more of the following ways:

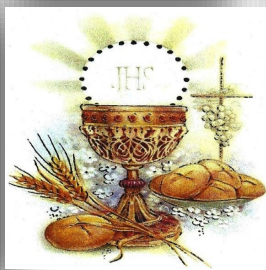


1. A special Mass of Thanksgiving will be held on *August 29th* at St. Francis Xavier in Cross Plains.*

3. Participate in and receive a commemorative booklet.

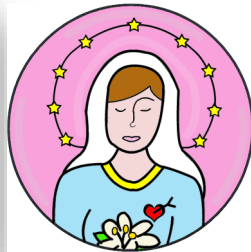
