## Council Member General Responsibilities

The Council engages in a continuous process of pastoral planning based upon the needs of parishioners, the needs of the diocese, and an authentic Catholic understanding of the mission of the Church.

- 1. The pastoral activity of the parish in which the Council assists the pastor includes, but is not limited to, the following areas:
  - A. Encouraging active participation in parish prayer and liturgies.
  - B. Promoting catechesis and evangelization for parishioners of all ages.
  - C. Fostering Catholic family life.
  - D. Encouraging community outreach.
  - E. Encouraging the performance of spiritual and corporal works of mercy.
  - F. Strengthening relationships with the diocesan Bishop and Church
- 2. The responsibilities of the Council under the direction of the Pastor and in cooperation with the parish staff include:
  - A. Discerning the strengths and needs of the parish community.
  - B. Developing, maintaining and communicating to parishioners a parish mission statement.
  - C. Engaging in ongoing strategic planning.
  - D. Assisting in the establishment of pastoral goals, priorities, and action plans for the parish.
  - E. Assisting in the formation of parish policies concerning pastoral matters.
  - F. Fostering communication, cooperation, consideration, and coordination among the different parish entities in order to become a more unified congregation.
  - G. Evaluating programs and processes.
