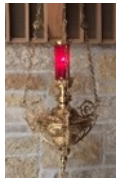

MILTON BOY SCOUT TROOP

NEWS: On June 7 our scout troop presented the Milton Food Pantry with a check for \$2,420 from the donations received from the free community breakfast we held at St. Mary's last month. In total, our scouts provided 237 service hours for the community. With the leftovers from the breakfast, Katherine Owens and Sara Thul delivered about 45-50 meals to the GIFTS Men's Shelter in Janesville and 40-50 meals to the Milton Food Pantry, most of which they were able to freeze for use at a later date. Our scouts also delivered 20 meals to homeless folks in downtown Janesville. The morning of the breakfast, we prepared and handed out close to 500 meals. The Milton Scouts would like to thank the community for all of their support!



ST. MARY EASES COVID

RESTRICTIONS: As COVID restrictions are eased throughout the state, here at St. Mary the following changes begin **this weekend:**



- ◆ Breaking Bread missalettes have returned, with a temporary procedure. The booklets are located in the Gathering Space. **Please pick one up on your way into church, and return it to the Gathering Space after Mass.** We

will use this method until new books arrive in November for Advent.

- ◆ We will continue to keep the east side of the church socially distanced with every other pew blocked off.
- ◆ Face masks are voluntary in all areas of church.
- ◆ All exterior doors are unlocked for entrance and exit.
- ◆ Masses will continue to be livestreamed.
- ◆ Individual chairs have been placed in the cry room for additional seating and along the back wall, only on the west side of the church. *****We are asking that the chairs in the back of church be reserved for those people using walkers. There will be room between the chairs to place walkers when not in use.***

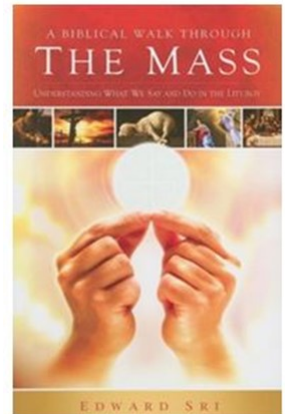
THE MASS STUDY

ST. MARY: Sundays at 9:30 a.m. beginning July 11 in the Parish Center



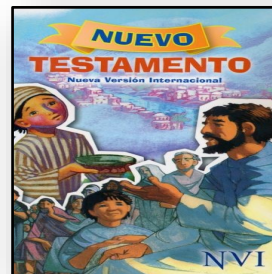

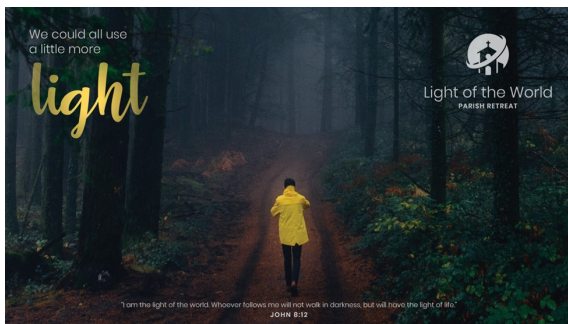
