A Note from Our Pastor ...



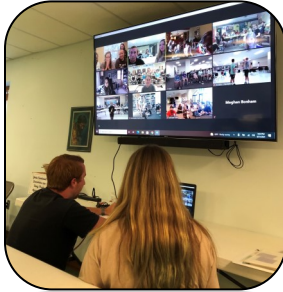

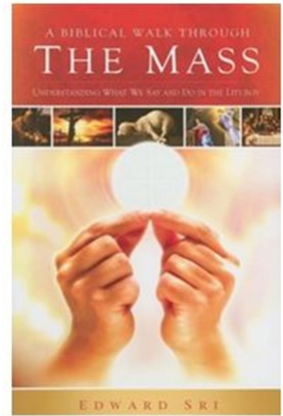
THE MASS STUDY
