As COVID restrictions are eased throughout the state, here at St. Mary we will make the following changes **next weekend**:


A Note from Our Pastor ...

We look forward to next weekend, when we can return to congregational singing. Many people love singing at Mass, and I do, too! Please know that we will keep a section of the church reserved for social distancing.



- Starting this Wednesday, the second Wednesday of the month Mass will be 2:00 p.m. at Milton Senior Living. There will not be morning Mass on that day. At this time, visitors are not allowed to attend Mass at Milton Senior Living.
- I will be leading short tours of the St. Mary's building after Masses starting today to help explain our need for the new building project—new parish center and offices (the church itself is in good condition, and it will stay as is). We hope our old buildings can endure one more summer and winter, so that we can build next spring. This will be a major project, and it will require fundraising. For comparison, we were able to raise \$400,000 in 2015 for the Priests for our Future Campaign, through the generosity of all our members. This new building project will likely require \$2 to \$4 million.
- Both churches will be showing the 5-part video series "A Biblical Walk Through the Mass" by Edward Sri, open to anyone. At St. Joseph, they will be Tuesday evenings at 6:30 p.m. starting June 22. At St. Mary they will be Sunday mornings after Mass starting July 11. Each video is 30 minutes followed by a facilitator leading short discussion. If you'd like the textbook or workbook, contact the parish business administrator.


