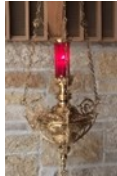

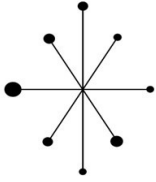
A Note from Our Pastor ...

- ✠ Here are my notes on “worship” during these weeks of the “Bread of Life” Discourse.
 - * As we worship, God delights in us (Psalm 149:4) and gives us his Holy Spirit, who leads us to worship more. In this way, worship builds up into something beautiful.
 - * We must pray and worship with our hearts. If our hearts are far from God, our words are in vain (*Catechism of Catholic Church* #2562).
 - * The Church encourages us to worship with full, conscious, active participation (CCC #1141).
 - * Use imagination in worship. In the first one-third of the Gloria, imagine the Father in front of you; in the middle section, imagine Jesus; in the last part, Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
