As with any budget, whether

Overall, for the last fiscal year that ended on June 30, we actually did quite well with keeping expenses way under what was expected. To avoid confusion with this section, and while wanting to be completely transparent to parishioners, we will no longer provide a total indicating whether the column is a deficit or there is a surplus.
