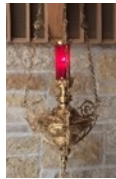

ST. MARY FINANCIALLY SPEAKING

SECTION OF BULLETIN: Each week we publish contributions from the previous week, as well as contributions from that same weekend last year. We also publish fiscal year to date totals. The bottom line in each section, whether deficit or surplus, is simply a reflection of how we are doing compared to our annual budget. As with any budget, whether

business or household, the amounts listed are an *estimate* of what is expected income and expected expenses. There is no way to determine the exact numbers without a crystal ball. Overall, for the last fiscal year that ended on June 30, we actually did quite well with keeping expenses way under what was expected. To avoid confusion with this section, and while wanting to be completely transparent to our parishioners, we will no longer provide a total indicating whether the column is a deficit or there is a surplus.

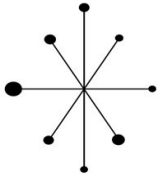

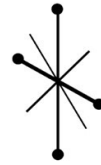
