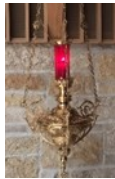

A Note from Our Pastor ...



- ✚ I hope that St. Mary members can stay after Mass this weekend for 30 minutes (15 min presentation, 15 min Q+A) as our new building committee members share with you about the proposed project. You will be invited to share your input in an online survey during the week September 5-12.
- ✚ You can contribute to disaster relief in Haiti by placing a check in the collection basket marked “Haiti.” It will support the work of Catholic Relief Services there.
- ✚ I enjoyed talking about worship and the Mass during the past five weeks, when our Gospel reading was from the Bread of Life discourse (John chapter 6). I used the occasion to introduce a chant in our Eucharistic celebrations—musical notes can be found at the top of page 12 in the missalette.
- ✚ Thank you to leaders from both parishes who facilitated the 5-part video series “A Biblical Walk through the Mass” by Edward Sri. There was good attendance when the videos were shown. I encourage all of us to continue learning about worshipping at the Mass.
- ✚ Here are my notes from the 5th and final week that I talked about worship and the Mass.
 - ⇒ In the Liturgy of the Word (four readings from the Bible), if we cooperate, the Holy Spirit lifts our faith, so that we are prepared to celebrate the Eucharist.
 - ⇒ It is common today for people to say, “I’m spiritual but not religious.” This may allow them to be uncommitted in their beliefs. Fewer people say, “I believe in the Bible and the teachings of the Church that go with it,” which involves a commitment. Each person must ask, “In what do I believe?”
 - ⇒ The most important reason we have to worship is this: it’s what we will be doing in eternity (Rev 7:15).
 - ⇒ There is a difference between “going to church” and “worshipping.” It takes time and energy to learn how to worship, but the effort is worth it! The key is to engage your heart with God.

Elementary (Grades Kdg.—6)

Option 1: Weekly Classes (begin September 21/22)

Tuesday 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. or 6:00 - 7:00 p.m.

Wednesday 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. or 6:00 - 7:00 p.m.



Our Tuesday/Wednesday Elementary programs provide catechesis (Catholic studies) for children in grades Kindergarten - 6. The four areas of study are Explore Being Catholic, Faith-Filled People, Time with God, and Sharing God's Story. We have not been able to secure transportation for the early classes, so we have the later class at 6:00 p.m. again this year providing families with four class options.

Option 2: Once-A-Month Family Faith Class (begins September 19)

1st Sunday of the month from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m.

Family Faith takes place after the 8:30 a.m. Mass once a month. Parents and their children study the Faith together. The session includes breakfast, fellowship, prayer, saints, Church Traditions, Scripture, games, family projects, and more!

Sacrament Prep: Reconciliation & First Communion

Formal preparation for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion (that means you get the special workbooks) occurs in 2nd grade. A parent meeting will be held in October with details and the presentation of the family curriculum.



Youth Ministry (Grades 7-10)

2nd Sunday of the month from 9:30—11:30 a.m. or 5:30—7:30 p.m. (begins September 26)

Youth Ministry includes youth in grades 7-10 who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Gatherings include Scripture, Catholic Tradition, Saints, Prayer, fellowship, and Apostolic Actions (service).

Confirmation

Candidates choose their sponsor and saint name in their sophomore year. St. Mary provides a group Confirmation retreat. The bishop's office will notify the parish of the Confirmation celebration date.
