donating the needed items. If you are unable, please keep all the babies in your prayers. *Thank you very much, St. Joseph*

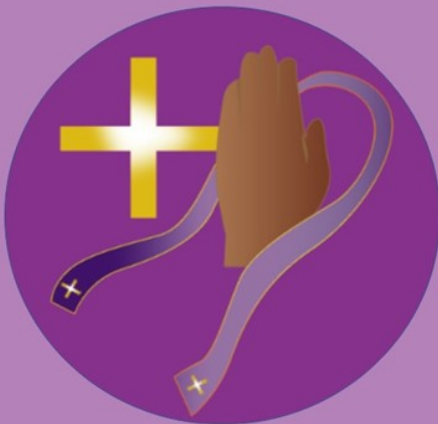
