



A Note from Our Pastor ...

- Last weekend I spoke about marriages at our two parishes. There is more information in the chart below.
- All parishes in the diocese, including St. Joseph and St. Mary, will be participating in a 15-minute online survey about discipleship. It is being conducted by Catholic Leadership Institute during Oct 14-Nov 22. If you can participate, you will be asked to reflect on your own spiritual growth, and it will be confidential (results will be about the parish as a whole). We are trying to get the highest response rate that we can. The results will help us as we progress in Bishop Hying's Go Make Disciples initiative.
