



#### Today begins the Advent Season.

Advent comes from the Latin word meaning "coming." Jesus is coming, and Advent is intended to be a season of preparation for His arrival. While we typically regard Advent as a joyous season, it is also intended to be a period of preparation, much like Lent. Prayer, penance and fasting are appropriate during this season.

# Advent Week 1: Purple Advent Candle, HOPE

In the first week of Advent, we recall the Prophet Isaiah, who anticipated the birth of Jesus. This first candle also represents the anticipation of the arrival of the Messiah.

A Mote from Our Pastor ...

Today is the start of Advent, and it is also the start of a new Church year (so we have new missalettes). The word Advent means "the Coming," and we think of Jesus' first coming, when he walked this earth. We think of his Second Coming, future. Then there are these little corriges which are



he walked this earth. We think of his Second Coming, which is in the future. Then there are those little comings, which are frequent, when Jesus breaks through and makes himself known to us. I believe we will all have a "little coming" during this season. The innkeeper wasn't ready when Jesus came as a baby, not having room at the inn. Let us be ready when he comes!

- Bishop Hying has established today as the starting date for Phase II of the "Go Make Disciples" evangelization initiative. Phase I has happened during the past year, and it was for parish leaders. Phase II calls for participation by all church-going members. In the coming year I will talk often about the Phase II Plan for St. Joseph and St. Mary parishes.
- On the Sundays of Advent I will be talking about the four parts of the Gospel. They are: the goodness of creation (today's topic); the tragedy of sin; the plan of restoration; and the response of faith. Some find it easier to remember four action-packed words that begin with "R": relationship, ruin, rescue, response.
- I am grateful that Fr. Savio Yerasani of the Diocese of Nellore in India was able to be with us last weekend. Please be generous in supporting the mission work in his diocese.
- I am seeking a full-time evangelization coordinator, a paid staff position. Please see the announcement in this bulletin.
