




BISHOP HYING VISIT TO ST. MARY and ST. JOSEPH Saturday, November 13



A Mote from Our Pastor ...

- Thank you to everyone at both parishes who participated in our offertory program last weekend. This helps us in financial planning and in the individual discipline of giving.
- Please complete the online Disciple Maker Index survey by going to the St. Joseph or St. Mary website and clicking on the link. It takes 15 minutes to complete. If you don't have a computer, please take home a paper survey and return it to church by November 22. We have 174 members from our two parishes who have completed the survey online—thank you!
- Bishop Hying will visit both of our churches and preside at Mass on Saturday, November 13. He will be here an hour before 4:00 p.m. Mass in Milton and an hour after 5:45 p.m. Mass in Edgerton for anyone to talk with him. It will be neat to be with him!
- St. Mary-Milton is continuing its new building project. Our fundraiser has estimated that we can raise \$1.5-3.5 million, and our builder has estimated the job, using our current design, at \$5.0-5.5 million. We are investigating the cost with another builder, a task which takes about 5 weeks. Soon we hope to have the estimate. Our committee will keep us informed of the details.
