A Note from Our Pastor ...

- ✠ Thank you to everyone at both parishes who participated in our offertory program last weekend. This helps us in financial planning and in the individual discipline of giving.
- ✠ Please complete the online *Disciple Maker Index* survey by going to the St. Joseph or St. Mary website and clicking on the link. It takes 15 minutes to complete. If you don't have a computer, please take home a paper survey and return it to church by November 22. We have 174 members from our two parishes who have completed the survey online—thank you!
- ✠ Bishop Hying will visit both of our churches and preside at Mass on Saturday, November 13. He will be here an hour before 4:00 p.m. Mass in Milton and an hour after 5:45 p.m. Mass in Edgerton for anyone to talk with him. It will be neat to be with him!
- ✠ St. Mary-Milton is continuing its new building project. Our fundraiser has estimated that we can raise \$1.5-3.5 million, and our builder has estimated the job, using our current design, at \$5.0-5.5 million. We are investigating the cost with another builder, a task which takes about 5 weeks. Soon we hope to have the estimate. Our committee will keep us informed of the details.
