

Go Make Disciples

Bishop Hying's initiative seeks to activate every parish in the diocese in the work of evangelization. To support that, he also wants all of us to grow in the four holy habits: 1) reclaim Sunday as a day of worship and rest; 2) personal prayer at least 15 minutes a day; 3) Friday as a day of fasting and penance/mortification; 4) monthly confession.

Our evangelization team has set the following goals for both parishes in this year:

- ⇒ opportunities to join 7-week small groups with trained leaders, Feb and Sept
- ⇒ promote <u>formed.org</u> videos on evangelization and the four holy habits
 - [featured video for December-January: The Search (7 x 25 mins)]
- ⇒ incorporate ideas and activities into elementary to high school faith formation classes
- ⇒ encourage all to intercede for our evangelization efforts, especially during Eucharistic Adoration (1st Tues eve at SJ, first Thurs eve at SM)
- ⇒ promote Bishop Hying's regional mission at St. William-Janesville on March 6-8
- ⇒ all parish groups start and end meetings with prayer taking turns leading
- ⇒ timely homilies on evangelization and the four holy habits
- ⇒ encourage all to read Bishop Hying's vision statement dated March 2020
