





#### **WORSHIP NOTES** (from Fr. David's homily last week).

We can see the three phases of worship in the magi's actions. We fulfill these at special times in the Mass (I will include those occasions in parentheses).

- 1. Joyful praise (Gloria, Holy-Holy-Holy);
- 2. Quiet reverence (while kneeling during Eucharistic Prayer);
- 3. Sacramental union with God (Communion).

The three levels grow progressively deeper, and all of them are initiated by God. The more our hearts are engaged, the greater is our worship.



## A Note from Our Pastor ...

Go Make Disciples is for ALL of us! Bishop Hying's Go Make Disciples evangelization initiative began a year ago for leaders (staff, councils) of every parish in the diocese. We have now started Phase II,



- which lasts a year, and it involves ALL active church members. Next year Phase III will involve efforts to reach all the people in our communities with the gospel. Phase III never ends, because evangelization continues until Jesus comes again. In addition to encouraging evangelization by all of us, the Bishop is encouraging all of us to grow in *four holy habits*: pray at least 15 minutes a day, reclaim Sunday as a day of worship and rest, mortification on Fridays, and monthly confession. Next week I will write about specific Phase II goals for our two parishes.
- Bishop Hying invites all of us to a diocesan listening day on Sunday, February 27, 1:00 p.m. at St. Dennis Parish-Madison. It begins with Mass and continues with small group discussions where people can address these questions: where is the gospel being lived and preached in our diocese? Where is the gospel not being lived and preached effectively? The conversations will be condensed and sent to the US Catholic Bishops who will send them to Rome. This is all preparation for the upcoming synod for the universal church which seeks to discern God's will in the areas of "Communion, Participation, and Mission." Registration for the listening session on February 27th is required and you can register at <a href="https://madisondiocese.org/synod">https://madisondiocese.org/synod</a>.
