





A Note from Our Pastor ...

- We will gather for Palm Sunday Mass next weekend. There will be a long Passion reading, which is broken into four parts, and the assembly (that is, all of you) has a part. Please remember that the last syllable of "prophesy" is pronounced "sigh." I will invite us to go outside for the start of Mass if weather is good.
- Confessions at St. Mary on Tuesday, April 5 will start at 4:30 p.m., and confessions will be cancelled on April 12.
- Invite us to participate in the Good Friday collection, which supports Christians in the Holy Land and helps with upkeep of shrines visited by pilgrims. If you are not able to attend the Good Friday liturgy, which will be at St. Joseph, you can still make a check payable to your parish with "Good Friday" on the memo line.
- Easter Masses always have very high attendance, yet we will only have three Easter Masses (Saturday 8:00 p.m. at SM, Sunday 8:30 a.m. at SM, Sunday 10:30 a.m. at SJ). There will be an overflow section available at Sunday 8:30 a.m., but to ease the crowdedness, I encourage us to attend the Saturday evening Mass at SM. The Saturday Mass does fulfill the Sunday obligation.
