THE CHOSEN – Season 2, Episode 6: This week we learn of John the Baptist’s arrest, see the Pharisees plotting against Jesus and see Jesus heal a man’s withered hand. We also see Mary Magdalene fall back into some bad ways. As she returns to Jesus, she tells him “I am so ashamed. You redeemed me once and I just threw it away.” Jesus tells Mary, “I just want your heart. The Father just wants your heart.” Have you ever fallen back into bad habits and felt ashamed? Know that Jesus will forgive those who repent and give him their heart. Join us on Monday May 2nd at 10 am or 6:30 pm in the St. Joseph church hall as we discuss the Scriptures this episode, *Unlawful*, is based on and then watch and discuss
