ROSARY AT ST. MARY ON MONDAY

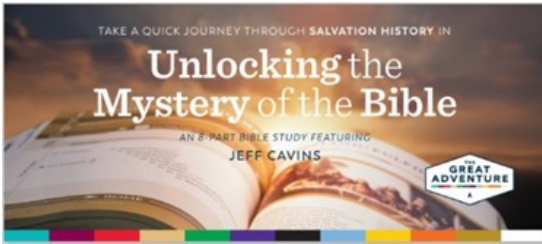
