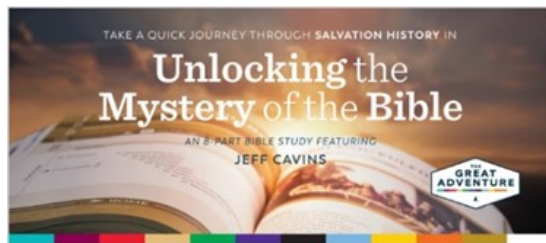

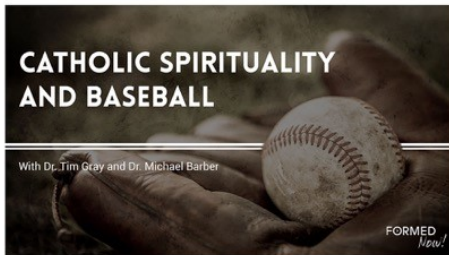
JOHN PAUL II IN AMERICA: UNITING A CONTINENT

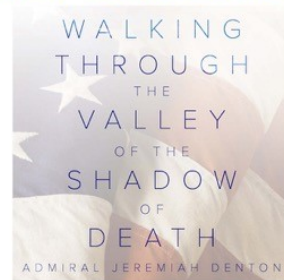

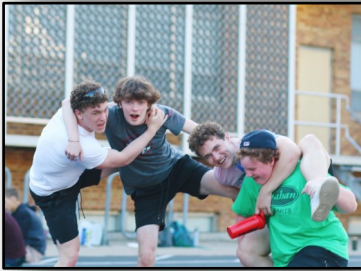

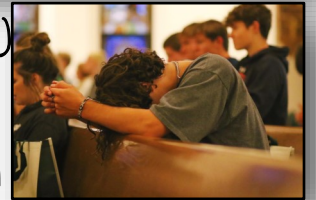
