## St. Joseph Knights of Columbus News

At the Pastoral Council Meeting in May, Knights of Columbus Brian Timmerman and Roland Breunig presented Fr. David with an Our Lady of Guadalupe icon. It is now proudly displayed in our church.

*Our Lady of Guadalupe* is a digital scan of the tilma of St. Juan Diego, first revealed to the world on December 12, 1531.

Cardinal Norberto Rivera of Mexico City authorized the tilma to be removed from the display vault at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and digitally scanned.

This archival print was blessed at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and donated to the American Wheelchair Mission for the specific purpose of raising funds for the delivery of wheelchairs.

The Silver Rose service promotes prayer for the respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of our nation and for the advancement of the message of our Lady of Guadalupe

*In 1960 a youth organization of the Knights of Columbus wanted to give something back to Our Lady of Guadalupe. They came up with the idea of running a rose to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in*



*Monterrey, Mexico. The rose was chosen to commemorate Juan Diego and the miracle of the roses, an important part of the story of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The first rose was a natural rose and was blessed by the Bishop of London. It was then flown to New York and then shepherded to Dallas, Texas. After several more stops, it was finally brought back to Mexico. But after a year, the first rose had decomposed. Today, eight silver roses run along different North American routes that include Canada and every U.S. State, Puerto Rico, District of Columbia and Mexico.*

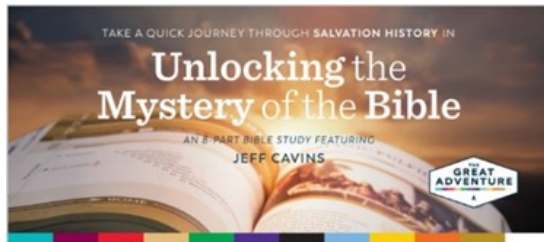

After discussion with Catholic Mutual Insurance and St. Mary Pastoral Council, it has been determined that we need a security committee. The purpose of this committee is to propose a security plan that will ensure the safety of our church, our parish staff and all parishioners. We would coordinate our efforts with local law enforcement and take into consideration recommendations proposed by Catholic Mutual Insurance Company. Some recommendations are already in the works, such as security cameras in church. But this is only one step in securing our parish. 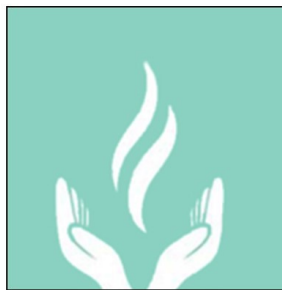

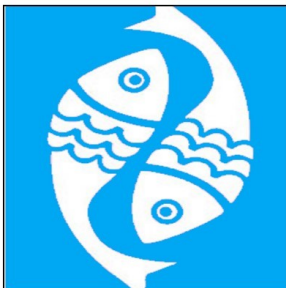

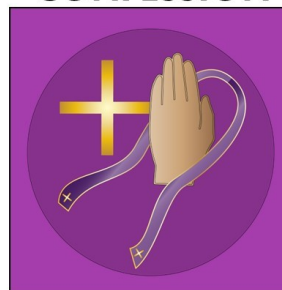
