

Our Lady of Guadalupe is a digital scan of the tilma of St. Juan Diego, first revealed to the world on December 12, 1531.

Cardinal Norberto Rivera of Mexico City authorized the tilma to be removed from the display vault at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and digitally scanned.

This archival print was blessed at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and donated to the American Wheelchair Mission for the specific purpose of raising funds for the delivery of wheelchairs.

**KC SILVER ROSE THIS WEEKEND:** On Sunday, August 7th, the Knights of Columbus will hold a Silver Rose prayer service at both St. Mary and St. Joseph parishes immediately

following their Masses. The Silver Rose service promotes prayer for the respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of our nation and for the advancement of the message of our Lady of Guadalupe

In 1960 a youth organization of the Knights of Columbus wanted to give something back to Our Lady of Guadalupe. They came up with the idea of running a rose to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in

Monterrey, Mexico. The rose was chosen to commemorate Juan Diego and the miracle of the roses, an important part of the story of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The first rose was a

natural rose and was blessed by the Bishop of London. It was then flown to New York and then shepherded to Dallas, Texas. After several more stops, it was finally brought back to Mexico. But after a year, the first rose had decomposed. Today, eight silver roses run along different North American routes that include Canada and every U.S. State, Puerto Rico, District of Columbia and Mexico.


