Stockbox distribution needs helpers. This is a great program for seniors who run out of food and money toward the end of the month. The distribution happens on the fourth Thursday each month. Through ECHO (Janesville) we receive pre-filled boxes of nice food items to distribute to a dozen or so families. The clients pick-up their own box from our parish center. Clients are called on the Wednesday prior to pick-up. This takes about 15 minutes. It is just a reminder to pick up their box the following day.

Helpers arrive at the parish center about 10:15 a.m., check to see if there are items in the refrigerator and prepare to greet the clients. Clients pick-up their box between 11:00 and 11:30 a.m. You are finished and ready to leave, to perhaps enjoy a nice lunch, by noon.



While we typically regard Advent as a joyous season, it is also intended to be a period of preparation, much like Lent. Prayer, penance, and fasting are appropriate during this season.

In the first week of Advent, we recall the Prophet Isaiah, who anticipated the birth of Jesus. This first candle also represents the anticipation of the arrival of the Messiah.

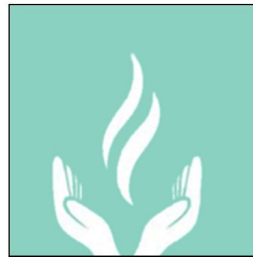

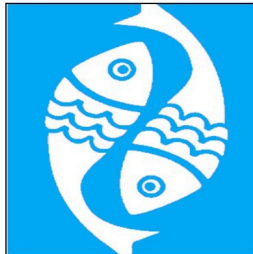

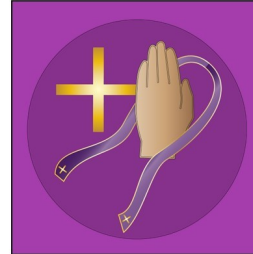
