




A Note from Our Pastor ...

- In view of the celebrations of St. Patrick Day, Bishop Hying has dispensed all Catholics in our diocese from the obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 17. He does encourage us, however, to participate in some act of penance or charity on that day.
