Evangelization is a requirement of love. In the first place, we must evangelize out of a

sincere love for God, "who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Tim 2:4). Second, our love for others implies that we sincerely desire their good, and especially their ultimate good, which is eternal life with God in heaven, which can only be obtained by faith in Jesus Christ. And finally, our own salvation is also at stake. For Jesus says to us: "Everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven; but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven" (Matt 10:32-33).

The goal of evangelization is to bring people to repentance and faith, which implies a radical conversion to a life of continual growth as an intentional disciple of Jesus Christ. By faith we offer our minds to God, believing all that he has revealed to us in and through his Son Jesus Christ because of our complete trust in his perfect wisdom and perfect truthfulness. By repentance we offer our hearts to God in a way that necessarily involves (1) acknowledgement of personal sin; (2) true sorrow for our sins; (3) a firm and sincere intention not to sin anymore; (4) and for Catholics, the intention of going to confession. Conversion, therefore, involves a complete transformation of our whole lives.

As part of his 2022-2023 Parish Missions, Bishop Hying is coming to St Mary and St Joseph Parishes the weekend of May 21 & 22, 2023. We will have more details as we get closer. The intended schedule is 6:00PM - Holy Hour with Confessions; 7:00PM - Bishop Hying Talks to the Congregation; 8:00PM - Q&A with Bishop Hying.

WELCOMING

As a way to further open our doors to welcome others, we would like to remind everyone that our Adult and Teen small groups and youth & teen groups are open to those outside of Catholicism. Each group introduction includes what they will be covering. If you know someone that isn't Catholic but might like to join a group, feel free to give the information about the group to that person.

In that same mindset, we are always looking for families to help greet people before mass. If you and your family is able, please think about signing up to greet at 1 mass a month. Our greeters extend the welcome to visitors, newer arrivals, and the regulars attendees.

Monthly Family Task: Talk to your children about sharing kindness and welcoming gestures. I always love seeing the students being so kind to our children with extra needs. Still, I see bullying in the schools, too often. So also talk to your children on how

"Jesus the Nazarian "John 13:35, NAB to be an upstander; to stand up for those that are being bullied by others. Being an upstander may be talking to the bully or it might be making a trusted adult aware of the bullying actions. I always tell my students to never put themselves in danger if the bully is violent, but to run for an adult. As Catholics, we are called to be kind to others and to respect their Human Dignity, and this is 1 step that they are able to take towards showing others they believe in God's Love.
