How can you do that if you don't know who exactly is in need? Edgerton Outreach and Gifts for Kids will be running drives in the coming weeks to help provide some Christmas

cheer to those children in families facing financial hardships. Edgerton Outreach is always accepting the donation of food items to be given to families and children in need (Edgerton Outreach provides weekend food to children through Grub Club). Edgerton School District runs a winter gear closet and are always looking for spare clothing and winter outdoor clothing items to stock their closet. They do accept gently used clothing and outerwear, so consider donating that which your children have outgrown.

Coming soon, we will have an extra collection at the weekend mass for the Community Thanksgiving Dinner, consider a donation through that collection or directly to Outreach for that event. They are always looking for volunteers, as well, so make it a family service project.

If your family has the space and ability, WI is looking for eligible foster parents. As a foster parent, you can make the difference in a child's life when they need a loving home to embrace them during a difficult time in their life.
