In all that they do, they are also finding a need for helpers to continue and expand their work. Changes will be coming to our parish...

Bishop Hying has started Into the Deep. This initiative will better align the offerings within our Diocese to match the needs of each area. During October, Father David talked about the need for this process. To summarize it, Catholics need to change our mindset from maintaining our parishes to acting as missionaries growing our outreach to those around us. Our goals are to not only reinvite Catholics that have fallen away from the faith back into our Parish Family, but we need to share our faith with others to bring others to Jesus. Our current church structure is not helping this mission process flourish.

In the coming year, we will see many changes to our parish. We will be merging with other parishes within our Pastorate. We will make use of cost sharing measures and remove duplicity between the churches to reduce costs and allow more of the funds received from parishioners to further our missionary tasks.

Tentatively, St Piux X in Cambridge and St Joseph in Fort Atkinson will be with us in a Pastorate. Our actual Pastorate churches may change when Bishop Hying makes the final decisions in January or February of 2023. Father will announce when everything is finalized for the Pastorates.

How will Faith Formation change? Nothing is changing for the current school year and we will continue planning for summer. Next school year is when changes will start. We will have some changing curriculums to align with our Pastorate and some changes in how Faith Formation is offered.

There are already plans to expand Family Formation, our in-home, family led formation with a monthly in-church meeting.

Beyond Family Formation, we have the weekly graded formation that we have all grown up with. That is were you will see the most changes. Any offered classes will have a blending of age groups to best fit both our youth's needs and the available volunteer Catechists.

More information will be known in Spring. I will point it out when I open Family Formation registration in March/April 2023.
