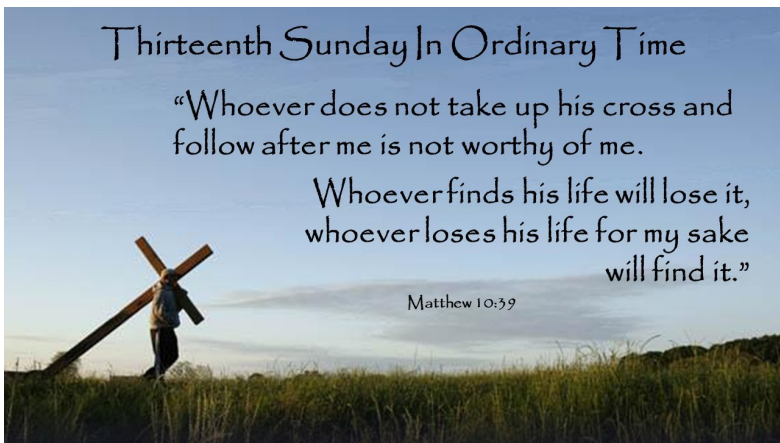

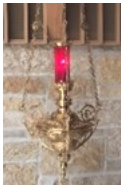

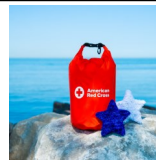

Please know that we will continue to keep our finances separate until we become one, which will not happen for at least a year. Therefore, if you drop your contribution envelope in another one of our pastorate churches, it will be sent here to St. Joseph. However, if you give unmarked cash, it will remain with the church you attended.

In addition, if you go to St. Mary in Milton, you may still put them in their collection, and it will be mailed to me as in the past. Or you may drop them in the mail or in a Vigil Light slot in the vestibule.

Another option you may want to consider at this time is to sign up for On-line Giving. It is easy to enroll, and recurring automatic contributions is available through the giving portal. Your parish contribution is automatically deducted from your savings or checking account. Debit and credit card payments are also accepted (with a 2.5% service fee). 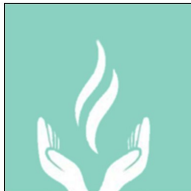

SUNDAY EUCHARIST

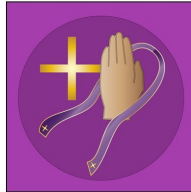
Reclaim the Sunday Eucharist as the center of parish life
