Saint of the Week: St. Bartholomew

Saint Bartholomew was one of the 12 apostles. Some biblical scholars identify him with Nathanael, from the gospel of John. Jesus paid him a great compliment: "Here is a true Israelite. There is no duplicity in him" (John 1:47b). He was one of those to whom Jesus appeared on the shore of the Sea of Tiberias after his resurrection (see John 21:1-14)

He is the patron of plasterers. His Feast Day is August 24.
