



## The Madison Diocesan Eucharistic Congress Friday, Sept. 29-Sunday, Oct. 1; St. John the Baptist, Waunakee



Before we go out into the world we need the strength of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. But we also need to see the realities of the world around us. In her talk on Saturday afternoon, Helen Alvare explores the difficulties of hearing and believing the truth of the Eucharist in our culture. How do we witness today?

Helen Alvare is a mother of three children and Professor of Law at George Mason University. Formerly of the USCCB in the Office of General Counsel and of the Secretariat for Pro-Life Activities, she chaired a commission on clerical abuse and advised the Pontifical Council for the Laity. She also practiced as a litigation attorney.
