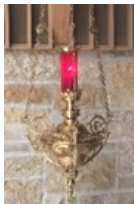

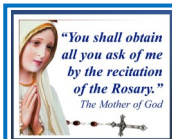

PREGNANCY HELPLINE ROCK COUNTY


The Crib of Life will be in the vestibule starting next weekend, October 1 through October 29. We will be collecting diapers, wipes, formula, and baby clothes. We are trying to give all babies a good start to life. Pregnancy Helpline gives free classes and instruction to new mothers that need a little help. The new mothers earn points for all classes attended and then use these points to get the items the baby needs. Please consider donating the needed items and if you are unable, please keep all the babies in your prayers.

Guidelines for Scheduling Mass Intentions

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for a deceased loved one is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition. In our pastorate, there are many requests for scheduling such Mass intentions. To allow as many parishioners and friends as possible to schedule Mass intentions, the following policies are put forth to help make the process easy and fair to all. We will begin taking requests for 2024 intentions on October 1, 2023.

- 1) Mass intentions will be scheduled on a first come, first served basis.
- 2) Mass intentions will be scheduled by using the Mass Intention Request form. You may turn-in or mail the completed form with payment to your local parish office.
- 3) A preferred and alternate date can be requested, but not guaranteed.
- 4) Due to fewer Masses, two (2) intentions per household may be scheduled; one (1) of the two may be for a Sunday Mass, the other for a weekday Mass. If a household's limit has been reached, new requests may be made for newly deceased loved ones.
- 5) Single Intentions with up to 3 first names with the same last name (i.e. John, Paul and Mary Smith) or one intention with two last names (i.e. the Jones and Smith Families) may be requested.
- 6) The suggested amount for a Mass offering is \$10, as determined by the Province of Milwaukee (i.e., all of the dioceses in Wisconsin), although a voluntary offering can be made which is greater or less than the suggested amount. Any offering should be included at the time of requesting the Intention for the Intention to be scheduled on the calendar.
- 7) If your intention is not for a deceased loved one, please write, '(living)' next to the name so the Priest may say the appropriate offering of the Mass.



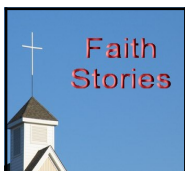
