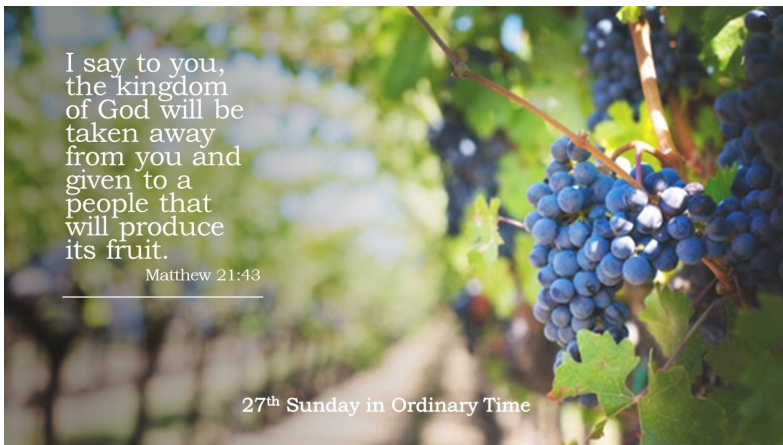

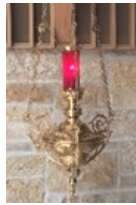

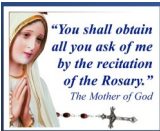
Items will be available for pick up on Saturday, **November 25, at St. Joseph Church, 590 S. Saint Joseph Circle, Edgerton.**
